1. Flowers or plants entered for competition must be more than ordinary standard and quality to be entitled to an award. Flowers in each entry must be of one variety unless otherwise stated. Plants will not be accepted for exhibition unless they have been growing in containers for two months.
2. All entries must be grown by exhibitor except in arrangement classes.
3. The judge will consider the following in awarding placings in these classes.
 - a. Cultural perfection, conditions of plants, color, foliage form, and well grounded.
 - b. The amount, size and color of bloom for the variety.
4. NO plant may be entered two years in a row.
5. Please allow extra entry time for multiple exhibits.
6. Chairperson is not responsible for the decisions of the judge.

**SECTION 3
SPECIMEN FLOWERS
ANNUALS**

1. Exhibits in this Section must be cut flowers grown by the exhibitor and must conform to the number of blooms, spikes or stems specified in each class.
2. The uniformity of height, color or size and condition of the leaves is an important factor in evaluating entries.
3. Flowers in each entry must be of one color and variety unless otherwise stated.
4. No two, or more, entries in same container, unless stated.
5. Flowers must be **CLEAN, TRIMMED** and **DEAD HEAD SPECIMENS**.
6. No leaves submerged in water, as they attract bacteria.
7. Tall flowers (like marigolds) should be in heavy tall containers (to keep them from falling over).
