***Please be aware that there are unique requirements associated with an event hosted at a State Fair.***

**Rules/Requirements:**

- 1. Registration Fees:** Leadline, Walk/Halt and PEE WEE riders - \$2 per class; **All other classes \$8.**  
Sign up two classes in advance. No refunds unless class is cancelled. A signed blank check is required from exhibitors to run a tab for entry fees.
- 2. Pre-registration post-marked by July 23, 2017; NO refunds**

**\$6 per class or \$25 per rider/all day**

**Make checks payable to: Clinton County Fair Association**  
Pre-registered entrants must check in at the Registration Booth prior to the start of the show to pick up back number, confirm classes and present required health and if applicable, registration papers.
- 3.** Each exhibitor/horse will need a fair registration number. The same number is used for all events during the fair. Complete mailing address is required. Each rider/horse combination will need its own registration number.
- 4. Premiums:** \$10, \$8, \$6, \$4, \$3, \$2. **Premiums will be mailed after the Fair.** Ribbons through 6<sup>th</sup> place.
- 5. PEE WEE riders** may only show in classes 5, 10, 13, and 14; trot only, penalty for canter.
- 6. Rider age divisions are as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of year.**
- 7.** Show committee will have the final decision and reserves the right to combine, divide and cancel classes.
- 8.** Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated and the show committee reserves the right to withhold premiums.
- 9.** Protective headgear is required for exhibitors 18 years and younger.
- 10.** Horse trailer parking in designated areas only.
- 11. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued after May 1, 2017 is required.** Equine Infectious Anemia (EIA) test results and date of the test must be included on the CVI.
- 12.** An Animal Owner or Caretaker's Verification of Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship (VCPR) form must accompany each animal and can be completed upon arrival at the exhibition.
- 13.** A copy of official EIA negative test results within 12 months prior to the show must accompany each animal.
- 14.** A copy of a rabies vaccination certificate must accompany each animal.
- 15.** No horse showing evidence of infectious or contagious disease will be admitted to any show or other fair event.
- 16.** No alcoholic beverages allowed on the Fairgrounds.
- 17.** The Clinton County Fair Committee will not be responsible or liable for any accident to any person, property or loss by fire, theft, storm or any other cause.
