1. Timed Obstacle Course (no beginners)
2. Beginner Pole Bending (walk/trot only)
3. Junior Pole Bending (riders 14 and under)
4. Senior Pole Bending (riders 15 to 19)
5. Adult Pole Bending (riders 20 and older)
6. Beginner Barrel Racing (walk/trot only)
7. Junior Barrel Racing (riders 14 and under)
8. Senior Barrel Racing (riders 15 to 19)
9. Adult Barrel Racing (riders 20 and older)
10. Beginner Keyhole (walk/trot only)
11. Junior Keyhole (riders 14 and under)
12. Senior Keyhole (riders 15 to 19)
13. Adult Keyhole (riders 20 and older)
14. Junior Cutback (riders 14 and under)
15. Senior Cutback (riders 15 to 19)
16. Adult Cutback (riders 20 and older)
17. Dash for Cash (no beginners) – Added money will be announced.

Please be aware that there are unique requirements associated with an event hosted at a State Fair.

Rules/Requirements:

- 1. All entrants including those who pre-registered** must check in at the Registration Booth prior to the start of the show to pick up back number, confirm classes and present required health papers (see below).
2. Each exhibitor must have only one exhibitor registration number. The same number will be used for all events at the Fair. All prize money will be routed by this number. Multiple horse entries will be designated by exhibitor number plus A, B or C for the day of the show.
- 3. Rider age divisions are as of January 1st of year.**
4. Show committee will have the final decision and reserves the right to combine, divide and cancel classes.
5. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated and the show committee reserves the right to withhold premiums.
6. Long pants and hard-soled boots with heels are required.
7. Approved, protective headgear is required for exhibitors 18 years and younger.
8. An exhibitor may enter each class only once.
9. Horse trailer parking in designated areas only.
- 10. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued after May 1, 2017 is required.** Equine Infectious Anemia (EIA) test results and date of the test must be included on the CVI.
11. A copy of official EIA negative test results within 12 months prior to the show must accompany each animal.
12. A copy of a rabies vaccination certificate must accompany each animal.
13. No horse showing evidence of infectious or contagious disease will be admitted to any show or other fair event.
14. No alcoholic beverages allowed on the Fairgrounds.
15. The Clinton County Fair Committee will not be responsible or liable for any accident to any person, property or loss by fire, theft, storm or any other cause.
