SECTION 1

VEGETABLES

1. Refer to General Rules and Regulations.
2. In selecting vegetables for exhibits, choose such specimen that would bring the highest market price. Do not select the largest, select medium sized specimens. If at all possible, do not mix varieties.
3. The following factors are generally used by an expert vegetable judge:
 - a. Trueness to variety type. If at all possible, pick the specimens from one variety.
 - b. Uniformity in shape, size and color.
 - c. Be sure to pick out a perfect specimen, then select the others as similar to it as possible. Never mix specimens of different maturity.
 - d. Free from dirt, disease, infection, and mechanical damage. Select specimens that are perfect and show no blemishes of any kind.
 - e. Condition and Maturity. Be sure that exhibits are of high quality.
 - f. Stems on beans (snap bush/snap pole) 1/2 inch evenly cut. Carrots, beets, etc. should have tops (leaves) removed from vegetables, leaving about 2 inches of stems.
4. It shall be responsibility of the exhibitor to make known the proper name of the vegetable he is entering. **Exhibit will be disqualified if the correct number is not entered.**
5. The judge may award a Best of Show ribbon for excellence.

SPECIAL NOTE: See Dept. 22, Section 15 for Vegetables that **might qualify** to be entered in the VEGETABLE RECORD BOOK Contest.

HERBS

1. Herbs will be judged on quality, fragrance and/or flavor characteristic of the herb.
2. **All entries shall be uniform, free from insect damage and dirt.**
3. All entries shall have a gummed label designating name of herb affixed to container.
4. Fresh green herbs (Section 1) should be displayed in a clear glass jar suitable to the size of the herb.
5. Herbs grown for blooms (such as lavender or yarrow) should be shown with blooms.
6. Herbs grown primarily for seeds (dill, etc.) should be shown with seeds.
7. The Judge may award a Best of Show ribbon for excellence.
