

DEPARTMENT 1 – HORSES

General Information:

1. Horse stall assignment will be handled through the Clinton County Extension Office. Stalls will be available to current 4-H members and volunteer chaperones, and Open Horse Show participants.
2. All General Rules and Health Regulations listed in this Clinton County Fair Circular apply to all exhibitors stalling horses during Fair Week.
3. Sawdust for bedding may not be available. Other arrangements may have to be made.

4. PEE WEE riders may show only in Classes 5, 10, 13 & 14. These are walk, trot and/or halt classes and may have a penalty for cantering.
5. The Show Committee and Judge will have the final decision and reserves the right to combine, divide and cancel classes.
6. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated and the show committee reserves the right to withhold premiums.
7. Protective headgear is required for all exhibitors 18 years of age and younger.
8. Horse trailer parking in designated areas only.

4. Unsportsmanlike conduct **WILL NOT BE TOLERATED** and the committee reserves the right to withhold premiums.
5. Long pants and hard-soled boots with heels are required.
6. Approved, protective helmet is required for riders 18 and under.
7. An exhibitor may enter each class only once.
8. Horse trailer parking in designated areas, only.
9. No alcoholic beverages are allowed on the Fairgrounds.
10. The Clinton County Fair Association will not be held responsible or liable for any accidents to person or property, or loss by fire, theft, storm or any other cause.

4. Approved Protective headgear and heeled boots required.
5. Horse trailer parking in designated areas only.
6. Member may use any horse that meets Fair Health requirements.

Good Housekeeping Procedures

1. These rules will be for all 4-H, Open Dairy and Open Horse
2. Livestock and Horse Exhibitors will be put into groupings by their species by chair when stalls are assigned.
3. Groupings will include between 3 and 6 exhibits for all large animals and should have no more than 15 for poultry or rabbits.
4. Those groupings will be posted at the 4-H Food Booth.
5. Good Housekeeping will be judged three (3) times throughout the week for each species. (This will not be announced, but will be at random.)
6. During each judging, one group will be chosen from each species as the winners.
7. The winning groups will be posted at the Livestock Show Ring Area. (Winners may receive a coupon for a milkshake or similar item.)
