SHOW RULES FOR GOATS

HEALTH RULES

1. A. All animals must have an official ear tag or official legible breed registration tattoo.
B. No goats showing clinical signs of contagious or infectious disease, including ringworm, warts, lice, and mange, but not limited to the aforementioned, will be admitted to any show.
C. Official Health Certificate (AA1-13) issued by the Bureau of Animal Industry must accompany all goats.
D. PA State law requires an Animal Owner or Caretaker's Verification of Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relation Form is completed within 30 days prior to show, signed and collected from each exhibitor.
2. This Show is sanctioned and will be governed by ADGA Rules and Regulations. Base date of Show is July 29, 2017. The Junior and Senior Shows **are not** separately sanctioned. The order of show is subject to change.
3. Pre-registration requested to be mailed to: Gwen Musselman, 622 Lafayette Rd., New Enterprise, PA 16664.
4. Registration fee: **\$5.00 per animal-Entries close July 23rd**. (checks payable to Clinton Co. Fair Association) Entry Fee Money is non-refundable.
5. Exhibitors must have animals on the grounds and signed in no later than **7:50 a.m.** Saturday, day of show.
6. This is **A ONE-DAY** Show - animals must be removed after the show.
7. All animals shown in-group or special classes must have been shown in their regular class.
8. The original Registration Certificate is required for all animals six (6) months of age and older and must be shown to the Show Secretary prior to the start of judging. Animals under six (6) months of age, the registration certificate or duplicate application stamped by ADGA will be accepted. Proof of animal ownership shall be the name on the registration, or the stamped duplicate. No copies of the registration certificate or stamped application, telephone calls or telegrams will be accepted in lieu of the original certificate. Note: The same classification and premiums, as stated below, apply to each breed. Use the following designations of breeds.
9. Pens need to be cleaned and inspected before you leave.
10. **No entry fee will be refunded for any reason.**
