MISS CLINTON COUNTY FAIR QUEEN CONTEST

OFFICIAL RULES:

1. Be a female who is a U.S. Citizen and a resident of Clinton County, Pennsylvania.
2. Be at least age 16, but no older than 20 years of age as of June 1 of the year entering the local contest.
3. Be the representative from the local Fair where she was crowned.
4. Have not been a former local Fair Queen winner.
5. Not hold any other title for any other commodity group or pageant during her reign.
6. Have her parent(s)' or guardian(s)' consent to enter the competition.
7. Be single, have never been married, have not been pregnant nor given birth to a child.
8. Act in accordance with the PA Fair Queen Behavior Policy.
9. Be able to meet all time commitments, Queen Obligations and Dress Code as set forth by the PA Fair Queen Program.
10. Contestant must submit her entry by June 24, 2017
11. Judging will be based upon poise, neatness, appearance, and ability to communicate. The decision of the judges will be final.
12. Winner MUST be eligible and available to enter the State Fair Queen Contest in January, 2018
13. Contestant must write an essay of 300 words or less on "What My Fair Means to My Community." The essay is due June 24, 2017. She must also prepare and present at the contest a 3-5 minute talk on "Why You Should Come to My Fair." Emphasis should be placed on "Agriculture." The 3-5 minute timing is very important as it will be considered when judging.
14. Wallet size photo of contestant must be attached to Official Entry Form.
15. During Fair Week the Fair Queen and Runner-up will make appearances at various activities as requested. When making public appearances, the Fair Queen and Runner-up should not wear jeans or shorts, or be accompanied by her boyfriend. Her sash should be worn when making appearances.

Awards of \$200 to Queen; \$100 to First Runner-up will be given after the completion of the Fair.

Queen will also receive the Dr. Douglas Casses Memorial Award.

The State Fair Convention will be held in late January 2018
